For the past two decades at the beginning of May, the historical reenactment 'Algodonales, May 2, 1810' is held to remember the events that took place in the town of Algodonales more than 200 years ago.

The reenactment will transport us to the beginning of the 19th century, when Spain was under the occupation of Napoleonic troops. In a small municipality of the Cadiz mountain range, an extraordinary event occurred.

The inhabitants of Algodonales united in an unparallelled act of courage to face the French army. Approximately 3,000 professional soldiers fought against about 200 peasants, who had no weapons other than their own tools.

The result was tragic: 240 citizens of Algodonales lost their lives and the Napoleonic trops set fire to some 70 houses.

This event marked a milestone in the history of the region, so much so that it was reflected in the cost of arms of Algodonales and left a deep mark on the identity of its inhabitants.

17.00 Inaugural Parade.

All of the associations and artisans who will be participating in the 20th anniversary historical recreation 'AL–GODONALES, MAY 2, 1810' will parade through the streets of the town displaying their banners and representative emblems. They will be accompanied by the band of Municipal School of Music.

18.00 Official Inauguration.

Mr. Ángel Acuña Racero, Mayor of Algodonales, will welcome the associations taking part in the weekend's activities and will hand over the baton to the honorary mayor for the reenactment, Mrs. Juana Nadales Márquez. Location: Plaza de la Constitución, stage area.

18.30 Municipal Auction of Craft Stalls and Taverns.

Following a century—old tradition, the Royal Auctioneer will collect tithes from each of the associations and artisans participating in the Historical Reenactment 2025. He will then deliver a ceremonial key to each stall holder.

Dr. Francisco Glicerio Conde Mora, vice president of the association Nuestra Señora Salus Infirmorum of Cádiz and Ceuta, Lieutenant RV and historian will give a lecture on Algodonales during the War of Independence (1808–1814), and the historical sources for his studies.

The arrival of the wounded from Montellano:

At the beginning of 1810, the invasion of Spain by French troops reached the borders of the island and Cádiz. Andalusia became a total war zone where the most powerful army of the time ravaged the land wherever it went.

The town of Algodonales welcomed the last defenders from Montellano, a municipality completely destroyed despite being heroically defended.

This dramatization recreates the arrival of the mayor of Montellano, José Romero, and his family along with the guerrilla fighter Francisco Salcedo, who came to their rescue.

These events will be staged by A.H.C. Algodonales Libre as a tribute to the courage and sacrifice of the people of Algodonales and in memory of the 240 men and women who died in the subsequent attack.

The fall of the town:

Dramatisation of the burning of a house in the town, which recreates the events that took place on May 2 when Napoleonic troops attacked Algodonales. An unmissable show of fire and strength!

Roclo Romero presents a show in which flamenco will be expressed in all its different forms: touch, singing and dancing. Flamenco has been forged by a people who sing to grief, love and joy, to their people and their customs, and the show will take it from its most popular origins to the CAFÉS CANTANTES, the cafe singers.

You are invited to join the girls and boys of Algodonales who will reenact events that took place during the days of assault on the village in a playful and fun way. Coordinated by the AHC For the Resistance of Algodonales, it's an event not to be missed.

The Sahara Desert, a thousand miles from any inhabited land...
